TOILETRY DRIVE COLLABORATION


January is Human Trafficking Awareness Month and in honor of this very important month Redeemed For A Cause Outreach partnered with its longtime partner and donor Narberth Presbyterian to prepare care packages. Together along with a handful of faithful contributors the annual drive was a huge success. The amount of toiletries and women essentials that were collected was so bountiful; that there was enough supplies to make "Code Blue" kits for the homeless population to help during these cold winter months. Additionally, there was enough supplies to share and distribute toiletry bags to one of our newest partners Rahatt's Devotion who supports teenage girls 10-16 years old by providing them mentorship and a safe space to build relationship with others from Philadelphia and surrounding areas.

Furthermore, our founder Dr. Sakinah Love was afforded the opportunity to speak on a webinar panel hosted by another one our partners CPOC (Citizens Police Oversight Commission) in honor of this powerful month. Together, Dr. Love and other experts in the field spoke from the topic discussion "Human Trafficking Beyond the Badge: Insight from Survivors and Experts in Philadelphia. The discussion was power packed and gave each expert the opportunity to share their insight for how the Philadelphia Police Department (PPD) and other law enforcement personnel can support this vulnerable population by working with professionals such as the panelist to support them.

Lastly, we would like to give a special shoutout to our founder Dr. Sakinah Love who will be starting a new position with Safe Exit Initiative in February. Dr. Love will be their Public Policy & Research Specialist; in which she will be developing and implementing public policy initiatives aimed at addressing the root causes of trafficking, improving support services for survivors, and increasing accountability for traffickers as well as monitoring legislative and regulatory developments at the local, state and federal levels that impact trafficked individuals and provide analysis and recommendations to the organization's leadership. Our founder will have the opportunity to use all she learned from her doctoral program in this new role and career job. Way to go Founder! Our organization looks forward to partnering and supporting Safe Exit Initiative in the near future.
